








**MERIDIAN STREET PRESERVATION COMMISSION  
RESOLUTION  
Topic: Time Limit**

RESOLVED: that orders issued by the Commission giving prior approval of a zoning variance and all certificates of appropriateness issued by the Commission may contain a provision that the work shall be commenced within eighteen (18) months of the date of the issuance of the Order. If the work is not commenced within such time period, the order shall expire, and the petitioner shall file a new petition if the petitioner wishes to pursue the work. Prior to the expiration of an order, a petitioner may request of the Commission Chair and the Chair may issue one (1) extension of time, not to exceed six (6) months, to commence the work

FURTHER RESOLVED: that all petitions for a prior approval of a zoning variance and all petitions for a certificate of appropriateness shall be deemed withdrawn if the petitioner has taken no action to pursue or advance the petition for a period of three (3) months, and the Commission's chair is hereby authorized to notify any petitioner whose applications has been inactive for three (3) months that it will be deemed withdrawn unless petitioner appears and affirmatively advises the Commission of petitioner's intention to pursue the petition.

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the chair and the Commission's counsel are authorized to commence such rulemaking as they may deem advisable to carry the foregoing resolutions into effect.
